- Setting a Budget: Consumers should plan ahead and decide how much they need to spend before they go shopping. By doing so, consumers will not spend more than what they intended to spend.

Common advertising and marketing gimmicks used by retailers

- "Combo Deals and Discount Thresholds:" Discount thresholds are when the retailer will offer you a discount, but only if you spend above a certain limit. Prices for a certain product can be a few cents to one dollar off or even five to ten dollars off its original price. While it may be tempting to take advantage of these offers, check to

see if you are getting value for money. If it is a perishable good, check the expiry dates thoroughly.

• "Gift offers" - some retailers offer a lot of gifts to a consumer when purchasing a certain product only to increase its sales. They understand that when people hear the word "free", whether the visual aid is appealing or not, they buy products, especially those that provide them with something for free.

Buying items on hire purchase
